In consultation with the St. Clair County Health Department (SCCHD), our district has decided to pause some of our higher risk athletic and extracurricular programs due to recent cases of COVID-19 at two of our schools. Effective immediately: Football, Soccer, Volleyball and Marching Band are paused at Port Huron Northern High School and Fort Gratiot Middle School. No practices, rehearsals or competition will take place this week. This precautionary measure will be reevaluated by the district and SCCHD on Sunday, September 20.
