In just this month over 200 applications have been submitted to different colleges and universities, both in Michigan and around the country. Over 15 university representatives have stopped by Port Huron High to share what makes their school unique and offer students advice on their applications. The Class of 2019 also had the opportunity to tour St. Clair County Community College and learn more about the programs offered there. The tour was a huge success and over 100 students have applied to SC4. Finally, MI Student Aid stopped by PHHS to help register students for TIP. TIP (Tuition Incentive Program) pays for a student's associate degree, and 77% of the eligible students were able to be enrolled.
