NOTICE - We are so happy and excited that our students will be able to compete in Football and Volleyball this season. However, due to restrictions there will be some new procedures for fans. Only **TWO** fans will be allowed entry at each game (each child counts as one fan). The student will turn in the names of these fans to their coach no later than the day before a game. We will have two different entries for the home and away fans at Holland Woods as follows:

- **Volleyball** - The home team fans will only enter through the back entrance to the building near the Custodial Room (entrance J). They will be required to show ID and their name will be checked off a list of those attending. Away fans will use the athletic entrance in the front of the building and will follow the same procedure. Masks must be worn covering the nose and mouth at all times.
- **Football/Cheer** - There will be a check in table for Home Team fans, and one for the Away Team fans. Home team will sit on the left side of the field, Away team on the right side. Masks must be worn covering the nose and mouth at all times.
- We will not be selling concessions during any of the above games.

Anyone not on the check-in log will be denied entry. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation during this time.

Families in Transition

If you and your family find yourselves struggling to keep a permanent residence, you may qualify for services and referrals offered by your child's school. Families/Students in transition may be:

- Living with relatives or friends
- In public or private shelters
- In public or private places not ordinarily used as housing, such as: cars or public parks
- Moving from place to place
